

Appeal to Commemorate

International Day of Nonviolence

The United Nations General Assembly has declared October 02 as 'International Day of Nonviolence' in 2007. This day is dedicated to preserve and promote the culture of nonviolence, mutual appreciation among communities and safeguard fundamental rights: freedom, justice, equality, opportunity, the spirit of democracy and secularism as well as to cultivate among individuals aptitude for inclusive living and respect for diversity, by means of social education and other expressions.

When the world suffers widespread political terror, when individualism is glorified as virtue, when lifestyle driven ecological calamity threatens us with extinction, when instance of violence deemed as infotainment, it is imperative on us to rededicate us for the promotion of sane lifestyle, oneness, sharing and mutuality. International Day of Nonviolence offers an occasion for this rededication.

Suggested Programme for nonviolence week

You may declare the week (Sep. 29 – Oct. 04) as Week of Nonviolence; organize a range of programme each day. The programme may focus on 'communal harmony', 'unity in diversity', 'inclusivism', social justice, youth empowerment, rural development, sustainable environment, human rights and individual responsibility... These themes may be deliberated in the form of essay writing, poem recitation, elocution, debate, quiz, artistic / stage expressions, public exhibitions, demonstrations, documentary screening...

Day 1	Sept 29, 2018	: Essay Writing, Elocution and Slogan Writing
Day 2	Sept 30, 2018	: Quiz, Drawing Competition, Poems and Peace Songs rendition; Exam on books of Peace, Nonviolence, nonviolent leaders like Gandhi, Nelson Mandela, Martin Luther King Jr.; Writing to media; publishing Articles and peace messages on social media.
Day 3	Oct 01, 2018	: Drama, Street Play and Musical evening
Day 4	Oct 02, 2018	: Peace March & Gathering at City Centre, Peace Demonstration with Placards, Banners, Public Meet; Exhibition of Posters and Peace Pledge; Display of Day 1-3 outcome; Power Point Presentation / Video Presentation, Peace Dining
Day 5	Oct 03, 2018	: Youth Camp, Conference, Seminar, on Nonviolence and peace in the contemporary World; Sustainable Development, 'Clean City Green City' Drive...
Day 6	Oct 04, 2018	: Swadeshi Day / Organic Day, Khadi Day ; sale of literatures on Nonviolence, Swadeshi, of Gandhi and other world leaders; Screening Films like Attenborough's 'Gandhi', Al Gore's 'Inconvenient Truth';

This year being 150th birth anniversary of Gandhiji as well as Kastruba Gandhiji, the nation celebrates the occasion as "Ba-bapu 150".

You may also organize, this year, commemoration programmes.

1. Adopt a village and help them achieve comprehensive transformation.

2. Organize total sanitation programme in a locality.

3. Organize de-addiction campaign among youth.

4. Initiate watershed management, particularly rainwater harvesting in villages.

5. Organize value education in rural schools
